

## Common Kingfisher *Alcedo atthis*

2005 minimum 1,361 pairs. For Kingfishers, the RBBP report has included data based on returns from recorders since 1996. The Kingfisher totals are variable, from accurate counts of known nests to estimates based on sites recording this species during the breeding season. The regional and UK totals are therefore minima and should be used cautiously. The breakdown by recording area is given below.
